



Faly Academy Player Code of Conduct

Faly Academy Players are expected to:

1. Wear appropriate attire/uniform, whenever they are travelling, training, playing or in any other manner representing the Faly Academy ("FA"), and to conduct themselves, at all times, in a manner that will positively represent the FA.
2. Be polite, respectful and considerate with the entire FA Community: coaches, managers, players, volunteers, parents and anyone from the community during all training, games, tournaments or any activities organized by FA in Canada or abroad.
3. Players are reminded that in most instances, they are guests and should always conduct themselves as such.
4. Players must follow and understand the rules put in place by the FA and its staff. When travelling all rules must be strictly followed. Following curfew at all functions and events is strictly enforced.
5. The use or possession of any mood altering substances, whether legal or illegal, including, without limitation, alcohol, tobacco, vaping/e-juice, marijuana, shall not be tolerated.

Code of Conduct – Players

1. I will participate because I want to, not just because my parents or coaches want me to.
2. I will play within the Laws of the Game and in the spirit of the game.
3. I will remember that participation in sports is a privilege, not a right and that I am expected to represent FA with respect, both on and off the field. I commit to exhibit good character, and conduct myself as a positive role model for all players.
4. I will live and play with class; be a good sport; be gracious in victory and accept defeat with dignity; give fallen opponents help, compliment extraordinary performance, show sincere respect in pre and post-game rituals.
5. I will not engage in disrespectful conduct of any sort including profanity, obscene gestures and offensive remarks of a sexual or racial nature, trash-talking, taunting, boastful celebrations or other actions that demean individuals or the sport.
6. I will exercise self-control; I will not fight or show excessive displays of anger or frustration and will have the strength to overcome the temptation to retaliate.
7. I will show respect for coaches, game officials, team-mates and opposing players at all times. Infractions that occur during the game are governed by the Laws of the Game and will be decided by the appointed game official/s.
8. I will treat all game officials with respect; I will not complain about or argue with a game official's calls or decisions during or after the match.
9. I will remember that winning isn't everything – that having fun, improving my skills, making friends and doing my best are also important.
10. I will not attend any team function (meetings, social event, training or game) under the influence of any mood altering substances, whether legal or illegal, including, without limitation, alcohol, tobacco, vaping/e-juice, marijuana.

Discipline

1. Persistent irresponsible and disrespectful behavior will be cause for dismissal.
2. Failure to comply with any and all team rules (curfew, attendance, dress code, etc.) may be cause for disciplinary action. Persistent failure will be cause for dismissal from the program for the remainder of the current season, and could affect a player's future participation.
3. Discipline issues related to players at games are handled either by the league, or for more serious cases, by BC Soccer. Refer to BC Soccer's Conduct, Ethics and Discipline Standards and Policy.
4. For discipline issues that are not game-related will be handled first by the discretion of the Faly Academy coaches.
5. For discipline issues that are not game-related, and are instead an internal issue, the process outlined in Faly Academy's Dispute Resolution and Appeals policies will be followed for those wishing to issue a complaint against a player, team official, parent, staff member, volunteer or anyone else aligned with Faly Academy.
